

Teaching Pet Safety TO CHILDREN

Never approach any animal when he or she is eating, sleeping, chewing on a toy, in its crate or caring for its young.

Always ask an adult before approaching an animal he or she doesn't know. This is especially true for pets that are service animals.

Teach your children not to provoke or tease a strange animal. Half of all attacks to children are considered provoked.
